

Tipping Guidelines:

The staff aren't paid very well and work hard to give you great service. A couple of dollars really goes a long way. You definitely don't need to tip 20% (like here in the US). On average, I would say around \$50-\$75/day per couple is plenty. You will need to bring smaller bills with you (\$1's and \$5's).

Here is a general guideline for tipping:

- -Drinks: \$5-10 for the 1st drink and \$1 for each thereafter. If you're going to be sitting around the swim up bar drinking all day, give them a \$20 at the beginning of the day:)
- -Restaurant and waitstaff for:

Breakfast: \$5 Lunch: \$10 Dinner: \$20

- -Housekeeping: \$3-\$5/day
- -Mini fridge restocking: \$3/day
- -Drivers to the resort from the airport: \$2/bag
- -Excursion guide: \$5-\$10/person
- -If you have butler service: \$25 on first day and \$5/day thereafter

I recommend dividing the money up in envelopes for each day before you leave so you're not left doing math every night on vacation. Most resorts have an in-room safe for you to program and store any cash not on you.
